Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

One of my most treasured books in my library is a book by Dr. Richard Owen Roberts entitled "*Revival*." While most of my books I have read only once, I have read this book many times and refer to it often.

In this book, Dr. Roberts tells us what revival is, when it is needed and what hinders us from having revival. There is one chapter however, that I must confess I did not even read the first few times I read this book. This chapter is entitled, "What are the dangers of revival?" Quite frankly, I did not read this chapter at first because I really didn't care about the danger. I figured if God sent revival, it was worth whatever danger was involved. And in a sense, that is true.

However, the longer I am in the ministry, the more I have come to realize that all the battles in our churches are not between individuals or different opinions about an issue. The battles we have in our churches are always spiritual battles. And considering that we just had a wonderful revival at PBC, I dusted off this old book and began to look at the "danger" chapter, one more time. Below are some excerpts from that chapter.

"True revival can be a dangerous and exceedingly fragile blessing. Revival carries with it almost unbelievable potential for good, but the potential for evil is likewise vast. Nothing can be stronger than the unleashed spiritual power of God, bearing all before it as a mighty tidal wave. But let foolish and biblically unlearned men prevail in the days of revival and its fragility is abundantly apparent...Just before a great season of revival, countless Christians appear to be spiritually slumbering and the devil's work seems easy. But let revival come and the devil must get busy just to protect his existing territory... As a counterfeiter, Satan has no equal. In the midst of revival, we must expect to find counter-revival...No task preparatory to revival is more necessary or urgent than the task of learning to distinguish between the work of God on the souls of men and the counterwork of Satan. One simple observation can help: what God does, He does for man's good; what Satan does, he does for his own good...If he can keep a people looking at themselves, their experiences, their feelings, and at one another, he will have assured the continued success of his own kingdom of darkness."

As Craig told us on the last night, let's pray, pray, pray that God will continue to have HIS way at PBC, and that revival fires will continue to burn.
