John Jay, the first Chief Justice of the Supreme Court said this: *“By conveying the Bible to people, ...we thereby enable them to learn that man was originally created and placed in a state of happiness, but becoming disobedient, was subjected to the degradation and evils which he and his posterity have since experienced. The Bible will also inform, them, that our gracious Creator has provided for us a Redeemer, who has made atonement “for the sins of the whole world,” and ...has opened a way for our redemption and salvation; and that these inestimable benefits are of the free gift and grace of God, not of our deserving, nor in our power to deserve.”*

In fact, Christian principles were utilized to establish our system for dealing with those who break our laws. Charles Colson, the founder of Prison Fellowship, said: *“Imprisonment as a primary means of criminal punishment is a relatively modern concept. It was turned to as a humane alternative to the older patterns of harsh physical penalties for nearly all crimes. Quakers introduced the concept in Pennsylvania.*

The first America prison was established in Philadelphia when the Walnut Street Jail was converted into a series of solitary cells where offenders were kept in solitary confinement. The theory was that they would become “penitents,” confessing their crimes before God and thereby gaining a spiritual rehabilitation. Hence, the name “penitentiary” --- a place for penitents.

May our country once again return to its roots is my prayer. May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you. RCA
