WAYS YOU AND YOUR CHURCH CAN HELP:

- 1) COLLECT ITEMS AND PREPARE BACKPACKS to be taken to a regional distribution center on Saturday, November 2. (Please turn in your backpack prior to this date.) Each zippered school backpack should include:
- a) Small items of **NEW items of warm clothing** such as winter hats, gloves, socks, underwear, scarves, etc.
- b) Small pop-top canned food such as ravioli, tuna, beef stew, vegetables, fruit (3-4 cans)
- c) At least one **NEW**, age appropriate non-breakable toy (no toy weapons, please!) This can include small cars, balls, dolls, small stuffed animals, yo-yos, jump rope, sidewalk chalk, card games, Legos, etc. For oldest age group (15-17) substitute an appropriate item instead of a toy, such as, a flashlight, small thermos, light blanket, books, hunting and fishing magazines for the boys - jewelry, books, skin care products, hair accessories, etc. for girls.
- d) Hygiene items including toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, washcloth, brush or comb, shampoo, deodorant (please fit these items into a one gallon Ziploc bag so they do not leak out into the rest of the backpack).
- e) Fresh, wrapped candy (no chocolate please, as it may melt)
- f) A children's **Bible** or youth Bible (no one version is required)
- g) A copy of "The Christmas Story" ** Church will provide this.

Packing Hint: The Bible and Christmas Story flyer seem to fit best in the front pocket of the backpack.

Age Grouping and Labeling. Each backpack should be labeled boy or girl as well as the appropriate age. New for 2019: Age groupings for this year are 4-7, 8-10, 11-14, 15-17. Due to labels falling off in previous years, we went to a ribbon system for labeling last year, and it proved to be very effective. Each backpack will have two 10 inch ribbons tied to them - one to indicate gender and one for age, as follows:

Gender:

Blue ribbon will indicate a boy's backpack.

Pink ribbon will indicate a girl's backpack.

Green ribbon for ages 8-10

Red ribbon for ages 11-14

We ask that you prepare your backpack as you would for your own child or grandchild, with new items, not used ones. This quality gift could be the only Christmas present this child receives, and will be a witness of Christ's love!




