Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

"A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. Now by chance a certain priest came down that road. And when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. Likewise, a Levite, when he arrived at the place, came and looked, and passed by on the other side. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion." Luke 10:30-33

Jesus told this story in answer to a question by certain lawyer. The lawyer wanted some assurance that he was doing everything that he needed to do to inherit eternal life. Jesus told him that all the law could be summed up in a few words. We are to "Love the Lord our God with all our heart, soul, strength and mind. And we are to love our neighbor as we love ourselves." But the lawyer needed more. He wanted to know, "Just who is my neighbor." The Parable of the Good Samaritan was Jesus' answer.

I thought about that story this morning. I got up early to take my wife to work. When I went out to get in the car, I saw my neighbor. He had been beaten. He was bloody. And was laying in my driveway asking for help. Apparently, he had been laying there for several hours as people passed him by, just like in the story.

My story from this morning is too long to tell in this space, but I wanted to remind us all that somewhere today, you are going to see someone who has "been beaten up by the world." And they will die without Jesus and without hope, unless we are willing to stop, help to bind up their wounds and love them like Jesus has commanded us to do.

C.S. Lewis said, "God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks in our conscience, but shouts in our pain: it is His megaphone to rouse a deaf world." When we see someone in pain, we have an opportunity to be God's voice to them. Don't just pass by on the other side.

May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you. RCA
