"God and Country" Luke 20:19-26

<sup>19</sup> And the chief priests and the scribes that very hour sought to lay hands on Him, but they afeared the people—for they knew He had spoken this parable against them.

# The Pharisees: Is It Lawful to Pay Taxes to Caesar?

<sup>20</sup> So they watched *Him,* and sent spies who pretended to be righteous, that they might seize on His words, in order to deliver Him to the power and the authority of the governor.

<sup>21</sup> Then they asked Him, saying, "Teacher, we know that You say and teach rightly, and You do not show personal favoritism, but teach the way of God in truth: <sup>22</sup> Is it lawful for us to pay taxes to Caesar or not?"
