#### Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

And we are hoping that those who serve on committees, teach classes and work in AWANAS, etc. will also commit to serving an additional year as well. We are hopeful that we all will make these commitments, so that when we are able to resume our normal activities, we will be strong and ready to work. Thank you in advance for understanding.

After much discussion, we have decided to continue to meet for worship in the FLC during August, and we do not believe it is safe to resume Sunday School, Wednesday services, or AWANA just yet. Our deacons will meet again on August  $25^{th}$  to discuss how and when we can resume these activities. We will have our annual Revival services in the FLC from August  $9^{th} - 12^{th}$  and look forward to what God will do during those services.

It is important to remember that PBC has been through much more difficult days than these. We have survived wars, economic depressions and even pandemics in our 247 years, and we will survive this as well if we remain in unity and keep our focus on "being a lighthouse to our community."

Please continue to pray for me, and our other church leaders that God would give us an extra dose of wisdom for the days ahead. Pray also that God will protect our members and will give us new opportunities to minister.

May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you. RCA
