Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

Each year, we look forward with great anticipation to September as first month of our new church year. People usually begin new ministry positions of leadership and service. We are challenged by a new budget. And we reflect on what has happened during the past year and promise to make this year better than the last.

But this year feels different. 2020 began with worries about killer hornets. Little did we know that they would be the least of our troubles. We moved from there into the COVID crisis, which has caused us to rethink how we do church life and our everyday life as well. While dealing with this, there were justifiable cries for racial justice that soon led to unjustifiable riots in the streets of several of our country's largest cities. As if that were not enough, then the natural disasters began. We had an earthquake, and as I write this, two hurricanes are set to give New Orleans a "left hook, then a right hook of trouble." In my 63 years of living, I have never seen a year quite like this one.

In the middle of it all, God has been faithful. And I am confident that *the* church and *our* church will come out of this stronger than before. These unprecedented events have caused us to learn new ways of doing ministry that will help us to reach people we might not have reached otherwise. I believe they have given us a newfound hunger for fellowship and Bible study that for too long had grown stale and unappreciated. And oh, what it has done for our prayer life! With the additional time away from work and school, and the uncertainty of the times, we have discovered that we are more dependent upon God than ever before.

So, where do we go from here? I am hopeful that soon we will gradually begin to add back our normal activities. We need to be in Sunday School. Our children need to be in AWANA, RA's, GA's and Mission Friends. We need the "shot in the arm" that Wednesday night Bible study gives. We long for the bonds of fellowship that are united around the church family table. But, we must do this in a way that will not imperil our most vulnerable members.

There are two events this month that I believe will help us begin this process. The first is on September 12th. Comedian Scott Davis will be here for a night of laughter and fellowship. If you feel comfortable doing so, please join us in the FLC for this event. Also, September 20th will be "Back to Church" Sunday. Please commit to being on the property that day, whether you attend in person, livestream in your car, or listen in the parking lot through the FM radio. These small steps will hopefully help us return to our "new normal."

MEETING IN SANCTUARY & SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS

This year has taken a toll on all of us and has forced us to change the way we do almost everything, including how we have met for worship. We have learned to attend church online in the comfort of our homes. We have learned to sit in our cars and listen to God's Word via radio. And due to your faithfulness in giving, we have learned to truly make our FLC a true multipurpose building. Thank you for your patience and your faithfulness.

After much prayer and discussion, the deacons and I feel that it is time to begin returning to our other buildings. And, as the State has done with business, we believe the best way to do this is in phases.

Here is our plan: On Sunday, September 6th, we will return to our sanctuary for worship at 10:30 am in much the same way we have worshipped in our FLC. Our sanctuary will have limited seating to allow for social distancing. Online and parking lot church will still be available.

On Sunday, September 20th, we will reboot our Sunday School, Children's Church and Nursery. Sunday School will begin at a new time, 9:30 a.m. to allow us to keep our 10:30 a.m. worship time. If all goes well with this reopening, we will look to begin AWANA and our Wednesday activities in October.

To make this reboot successful, it is important that each of us do all we can to protect those most vulnerable to this disease. If you are sick at all, please stay home and take advantage of online church. Wash your hands frequently and take advantage of the hand sanitizer that is available throughout the building. If you are able, wear a face covering when close to others.
