Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

The Forefathers Monument located in Plymouth, Massachusetts, commemorates the Pilgrims, their planting the colony of Plymouth, and their contribution to America at large. Boston sculptor Hammatt Billings, designed this 81-foot-tall solid granite monument, thought to be the largest solid granite monument in the United States. From the original concept in 1820 to the laying of the cornerstone in 1859 to its dedication in 1889, it contains in simple imagery the wisdom of the Founding Era. Standing at the center of this monument is a beautiful woman who represents Faith. She stands with one foot on Plymouth Rock, has an open Bible in her left hand that is well worn from reading while her right hand is uplifted to heaven. There is a star on her forehead which means she was given wisdom to live in this world. She looks down as if to call people to trust in God. Faith is at the center and is the tallest point on the monument there are four other statues that are beneath and circle Faith. Those statues are Morality, Law, Education and Liberty.

Morality: The Founders stated over and over that no nation can long endure without virtue or morality in the people. Samuel Adams said, "While the people are virtuous, they cannot be subdued; but when once they lose their virtue, they will be ready to surrender their liberties." This Christian character or morality is essential for a free nation.

Law: The Founders of America considered the Bible to be the source of truth, and they sought to not only build their lives upon its precepts, but also their civil laws.

Education: A people cannot be ignorant and free. Benjamin Franklin said, "A nation of well-informed men who have been taught to know and prize the rights which God has given them cannot be enslaved. It is in the region of ignorance that tyranny begins." The statue of Education is holding an open book of knowledge (the Bible), implying its truth must be passed to all.

Liberty: The fruit of a people with Biblical faith, morality, law, and education is liberty. Historian David Ramsay said, "There can be no political happiness without liberty; there can be no liberty without morality; and there can be no morality without religion."

Oh, that our nation could return to its Christian roots! Please pray that God will once again bring revival to this great nation.
