Appalachian Coalfields Ministry Backpack List BACK PACKS DUE BY WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4th

Or you may drop of at the FLC on Saturday, November 7th from 9 until Noon during the "Statewide" drop-off

- **A)** Small items of **NEW items of warm clothing** such as winter hats, gloves, socks, scarves, etc.
- **B)** Small **pop-top canned food** such as ravioli, tuna, beef stew, vegetables, fruit (3-4 cans)
- **C)** At least 1-2 **NEW**, age appropriate non-breakable toy (*no toy weapons, please!*) This can include small cars, balls, dolls, small stuffed animals, yo-yos, jump rope, sidewalk chalk, card games, Legos, etc. For oldest age group (15-17) substitute an appropriate item instead of a toy, such as, a flashlight, small thermos, light blanket, books, hunting and fishing magazines for the boys jewelry, books, skin care products, hair accessories, etc. for girls.
- **D)** Hygiene items including full sized containers of toothpaste, body wash, shampoo, and deodorant, as well as toothbrush, soap, washcloth, brush or comb. (Please fit these items into a one-gallon Ziploc bag so they do not leak out into the rest of the backpack).
- **E) Fresh, wrapped candy** (no chocolate or peanut products)
- **F)** A children's **Bible** or youth Bible (*no one version is required*) Please make sure that every pack has a Bible in it!

Age Grouping and Labeling. Each backpack should be labeled boy or girl as well as the appropriate age using 10" ribbons.

Age groupings for this year are 4-7, 8-10, 11-14, 15-17.

Gender:

Blue ribbon will indicate a boy's backpack. **Pink** ribbon will indicate a girl's backpack.

Age:

Yellow ribbon for ages 4-7; Green ribbon for ages 8-10 Red ribbon for ages 11-14; White ribbon for ages 15-17

"Remembering HIS Words"
Luke 24:1-12

He Is Risen

24 Now on the first *day* of the week, very early in the morning, they, ^[a] and certain *other women* with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. ² But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb. ³ Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. ⁴ And it happened, as they were ^[b] greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments. ⁵ Then, as they were afraid and bowed *their* faces to the earth, they said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? ⁶ He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, ⁷ saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.'"

⁸ And they remembered His words. ⁹ Then they returned from the tomb and told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest. ¹⁰ It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary *the mother* of James, and the other *women* with them, who told these things to the apostles. ¹¹ And their words seemed to them like ^[c] idle tales, and they did not believe them. ¹² But Peter arose and ran to the tomb; and stooping down, he saw the linen cloths ^[d] lying by themselves; and he departed, marveling to himself at what had happened.
