**Appalachian Coalfields Ministry Backpack List  
BACK PACKS DUE BY WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 4<sup>th</sup>**

- A)** Small items of **NEW** items of warm clothing such as winter hats, gloves, socks, scarves, etc.
  - B)** Small **pop-top** canned food such as ravioli, tuna, beef stew, vegetables, fruit (3-4 cans)
  - C)** At least 1-2 **NEW, age appropriate non-breakable toy** (*no toy weapons, please!*) This can include small cars, balls, dolls, small stuffed animals, yo-yos, jump rope, sidewalk chalk, card games, Legos, etc. For oldest age group (15-17) substitute an appropriate item instead of a toy, such as, a flashlight, small thermos, light blanket, books, hunting and fishing magazines for the boys - jewelry, books, skin care products, hair accessories, etc. for girls.
  - D)** **Hygiene items** including full sized containers of toothpaste, body wash, shampoo, and deodorant, as well as toothbrush, soap, washcloth, brush or comb. (*Please fit these items into a one-gallon Ziploc bag so they do not leak out into the rest of the backpack.*)
  - E)** **Fresh, wrapped candy** (*no chocolate or peanut products*)
  - F)** A children’s Bible or youth Bible (*no one version is required*) Please make sure that every pack has a Bible in it!
- Age Grouping and Labeling.** Each backpack should be labeled boy or girl as well as the appropriate age using 10” ribbons.  
Age groupings for this year are **4-7, 8-10, 11-14, 15-17.**

**Blue** ribbon will indicate a boy’s backpack.

**Pink** ribbon will indicate a girl’s backpack.

**Yellow** ribbon for ages 4-7; **Green** ribbon for ages 8-10

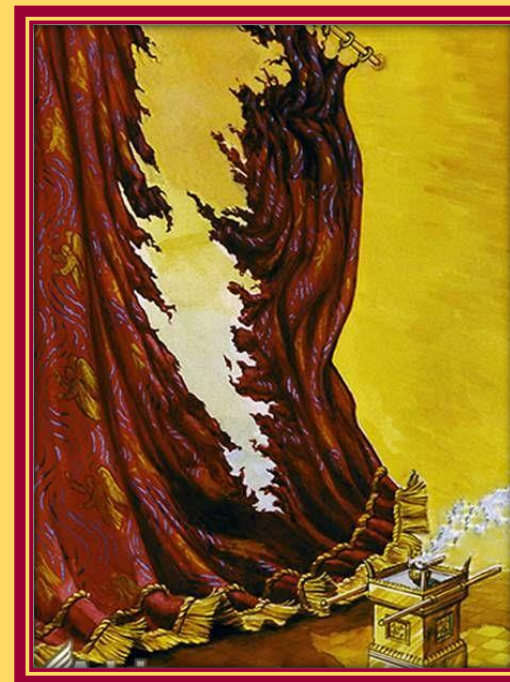

Luke 23:44-56

### Jesus Dies on the Cross

<sup>44</sup> Now it <sup>[a]</sup>was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour. <sup>45</sup> Then the sun was <sup>[b]</sup>darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in <sup>[c]</sup>two. <sup>46</sup> And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, “Father, ‘into Your hands I commit My spirit.’ ” Having said this, He breathed His last.

<sup>47</sup> So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God, saying, “Certainly this was a righteous Man!”

<sup>48</sup> And the whole crowd who came together to that sight, seeing what had been done, beat their breasts and returned. <sup>49</sup> But all His acquaintances, and the women who followed Him from Galilee, stood at a distance, watching these things.

### Jesus Buried in Joseph's Tomb

<sup>50</sup> Now behold, *there was* a man named Joseph, a council member, a good and just man. <sup>51</sup> He had not consented to their decision and deed. *He was* from Arimathea, a city of the Jews, who <sup>[d]</sup>himself was also waiting for the kingdom of God. <sup>52</sup> This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. <sup>53</sup> Then he took it down, wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a tomb *that was* hewn out of the rock, where no one had ever lain before. <sup>54</sup> That day was the Preparation, and the Sabbath drew near.

<sup>55</sup> And the women who had come with Him from Galilee followed after, and they observed the tomb and how His body was laid. <sup>56</sup> Then they returned and prepared spices and fragrant oils. And they rested on the Sabbath according to the commandment.
