Sermon "He Will Replenish What Life Has Taken"

Jesus Changes Water Into Wine

2 On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, **2** and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. **3** When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine." **4** "Woman, ^[a] why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come."

5 His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

6 Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. ^[b]

7 Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim.

8 Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet."

They did so, **9** and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. Then he called the bridegroom aside **10** and said, "Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now."

11 What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.

To our PBC and Facebook family: Christi had a "good night" according to her nurse. Her blood oxygen level is 88. When I arrived at the hospital yesterday, it was in the 30s. She is still battling an infection, but they now know what the infection is, so they can treat it more effectively. Her blood pressure is better and holding. To our PBC and Facebook family: Thanks for all your prayers and concern in regard to our family. You have been better to us than we deserve. As for my progress, I believe I am around 80 - 85% of the man I was before COVID. Sherrie, I would say is hovering around 60% but getting a little better each day. Our major concern is for my daughter Christi. I received a call this morning around 8:30 from the hospital. "This is Karen from the hospital, they are doing CPR on your daughter. Do you want them to continue?" That is a terrible phone call for any father to receive. By the time I arrived at the hospital, they had managed to get her back, but her blood oxygen level was in the 30's. (It should be in the 90's) Throughout the course of the day, they have given her various treatments to combat this terrible virus. Her nurse, Riley, assured me that Christi was her only patient and that she was her total focus. It has now been almost 8 hours since I received that awful phone call. Christi's blood oxygen level is around 76. She still has a fever. She is stable, but critical. She is where she has always been...in God's hands. Thanks for your every act of kindness. I will continue to update as I get more information.
