Adopt-A-Week will be on May 16th – 22nd.

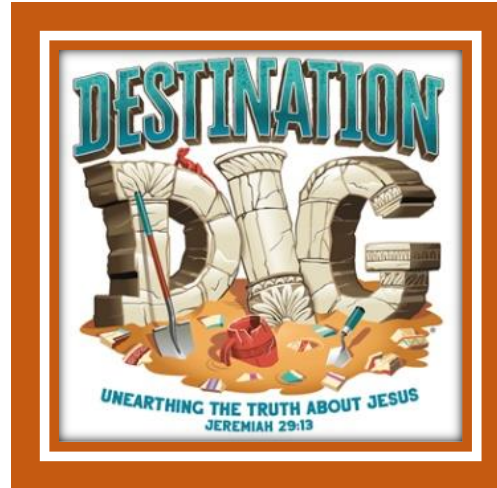
