### Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

This month we celebrate the birth of our nation. On July 4, 1776, the United States declared their independence from England by saying, *"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness."*

It was evident in those early years that our Founders understood the vital role that God played in the nation's success.

- John Adams is quoted as saying: *"We Recognize No Sovereign but God, and no King but Jesus!"*
- George Washington said: *"While we are zealously performing the duties of good citizens and soldiers, we certainly ought not to be inattentive to the higher duties of religion. To the distinguished character of Patriot, it should be our highest glory to add the more distinguished character of Christian."*
- Noah Webster said: *"In my view, the Christian religion is the most important and one of the first things in which all children, under a free government ought to be instructed."*

In 1939, with Hitler on the move in Europe, President Franklin D. Roosevelt, in his State of the Union Speech, reminded us again about the importance that faith plays in maintaining our democracy. This is a portion of what he said:

*"Storms from abroad directly challenge three institutions indispensable to Americans, now as always. The first is religion. It is the source of the other two---democracy and international good faith."*

*Religion, by teaching man his relationship to God, gives the individual a sense of his own dignity and teaches him to respect himself by respecting his neighbors...*

*Where freedom of religion has been attacked, the attack has come from sources opposed to democracy. Where democracy has been overthrown, the spirit of free worship has disappeared. And where religion and democracy have vanished, good faith and reason in international affairs have given way to strident ambition and brute force...*

*There comes a time in the affairs of men when they must prepare to defend, not their homes alone, but the tenets of faith and humanity on which their churches, their governments, and their very civilizations are founded. The defense of religion, of democracy, and of good faith among nations is all the same fight. To save one we must now make up our minds to save all."*

I wish more of today's Americans and today's political leaders understood these truths. We have been the greatest nation in the history of the world, but we too will fall if we abandon our Christian heritage.

May our Father bless America and you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you.



## UNION ELEMENTARY NEWS

Any child that will be 5 years old by August 31 should enroll as soon as possible. Connie Knight is our Data Manager, and she is in charge of the registration process. She is at the school on Mondays and Tuesdays from 7:00-3:30 during the summer. The county prefers that parents go to the UCPS website and register through the Scribbles program. However, if technology is an issue, we will gladly accept paper/pencil enrollment forms.

You will need two proofs of residence such as a power bill, phone bill, car registration, etc. You will also need the child's birth certificate. A physical completed by the doctor will eventually be needed, but this isn't a requirement to start the registration process. Students have 30 days after school starts to get the physical and immunization records turned in to the school.


Letters will be mailed to families the week of July 19 to provide additional kindergarten information and to give your child's staggered entry date. Please aim to have enrollment paperwork completed by July 19 so that you can receive the mailing.

In addition to new kindergarten students, we are looking for new families that have moved into our attendance zone. Any new student, kindergarten-fifth grade, will need to complete enrollment paperwork as soon as possible. Registering sooner than later helps us with planning purposes.

Union Elementary is a wonderful community school with low student to teacher ratios! I would love to speak with any parents that have questions. I look forward to working with you next year!
