Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

On March 14, 2020, Governor Roy Cooper issued his first Executive Order regarding Covid, prohibiting any gatherings of 100 or more. I vividly remember that day. It was a Saturday, and I was immediately hit with a decision about whether we would gather for worship at Philadelphia the next day.

The deacons met early on that Sunday morning. It was decided that since notice was given so late, we would have church on that Sunday, but would suspend services for the next two weeks to “flatten the curve” as the President had requested. As per the Governor’s Order, we reported 99 for Sunday School that day. And during our worship time, as planned, we heard from Kevin Qualls from Christian Adoption Services.

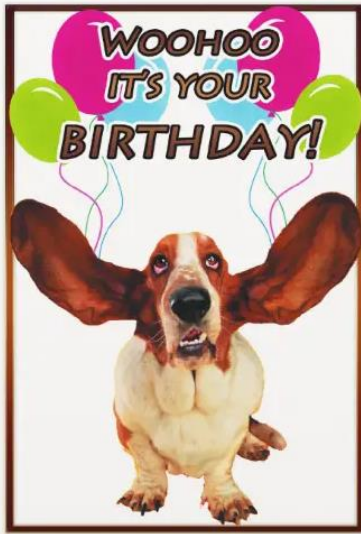
During these past two years there have been many changes. We have learned through trial and error how to use social media to deliver the Gospel in a new and different way. We purchased a lot of new audio and video equipment. We learned how to install and use cameras. We learned about a variety of new microphones including my favorite, the “dead cat” microphone. We learned how to do parking lot church, where you “honk your horn” if you want to say, “Amen!” When we finally moved inside, we had to learn to have fellowship while still appreciating the need to distance from each other.

We navigated the troubled waters of media misinformation and political rhetoric that could have divided us and brought disunity. I want to commend our deacons and staff for their leadership, flexibility, and humble spirit during this time. Many churches did not survive, and it’s possible that neither would Philadelphia without your servant’s heart during this time. I want to commend our congregation for your understanding and your faithfulness as we tried to lead during the first pandemic in our history in more than 100 years.

So, where are we two years into this? Our congregation is smaller. Researchers tell us that 30% of our congregation will never come back to anyone’s church. This breaks my heart, not as much for the church, although their loss will be felt. It breaks my heart for those who will walk away from the faith and will have to endure the chastening of a loving Father. Those same researchers tell us that 40% of those who do return will only be part-time Believers, no longer willing to commit to serving in any capacity. I am convinced that the researchers have underestimated the convicting power of the Holy Spirit, and that those who return will want to experience the joy that comes through serving.

How do we move forward from this point? First, we pray. Jesus is the One who builds the HIS church, so we rely on HIS strength. Secondly, we share the Gospel with everyone. We tell our friends, family, co-workers, even our enemies about the joy that comes from knowing Jesus. Finally, we commit ourselves to growing in our relationship with Jesus. We fall in love with HIM all over again. When we truly love HIM, everything else will fall into place.

May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serving our Lord with you. RCA

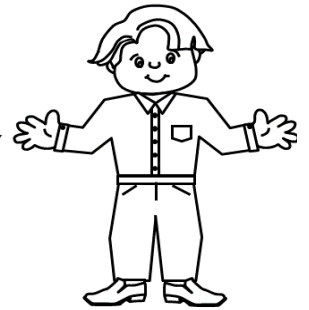
