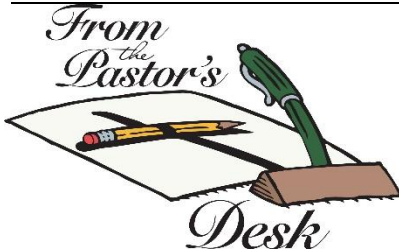

Basic Vanilla Cake



This moist single-layer vanilla cake has a delicate texture and delectable crumb, but it's the old-fashioned browned-butter glaze that gives it a nutty flavor. All you need is a few ingredients and tools (mainly an 8-inch cake pan).

CAL/SERV:332

YIELDS:8 servings

PREP TIME:0 hours 20 mins; TOTAL TIME:0 hours 55 mins

INGREDIENTS

- 1/2 c. (1 stick) unsalted butter, at room temperature, plus more for cake pan
- 1 1/2 c. sifted cake flour, plus more for cake pan
- 1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/4 tsp. kosher salt
- 1 c. sugar
- 2 large eggs, at room temperature
- 1/2 tsp. pure vanilla extract
- 1/2 c. whole milk

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 400° F. Lightly coat an 8-inch cake pan with butter and dust with flour. Sift together cake flour, baking powder, and salt into a large mixing bowl.
2. Beat butter into the flour mixture, one heaping 1/4 teaspoonful at a time, using an electric mixer on low speed, until the mixture resembles coarse sand. Beat in sugar, a tablespoon at a time, until the mixture resembles fine damp sand. Beat in eggs one at a time. Increase mixer speed to medium-high and beat vanilla and milk just until blended. (Do not over beat.)
3. Transfer to the prepared pan and bake until a wooden skewer inserted in the center comes out clean, 30 to 35 minutes. Cool cake in the pan on a wire rack for 5 minutes. Then transfer to the rack to cool completely.
4. Ice with Browned-Butter Glaze.

BROWNED BUTTER GLAZE INGREDIENTS

- 1/4 c. unsalted butter
- 1 1/4 c. sifted confectioners' sugar
- 1/4 tsp. kosher salt
- 2 tbsp. whole milk
- 1 tsp. lemon juice
- Zest of 1 lemon

DIRECTIONS

Melt the butter over medium-low heat until golden brown. Whisk the sugar, salt, milk, lemon juice, and zest together. Add the melted butter in a stream while whisking until smooth.

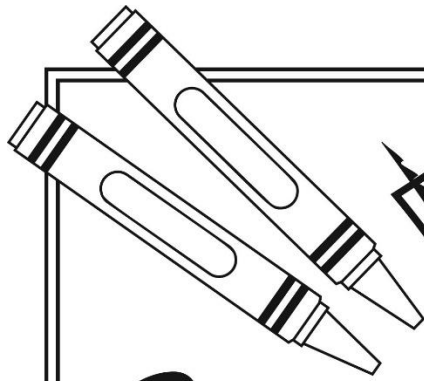
