Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

On September 11, 1777, at the height of the Revolutionary War, General George Washington was trying his best to prevent the British from capturing the seat of the American government in Philadelphia. His army of nearly 15,000 troops had taken up positions along



Brandywine Creek.

Washington believed that he had cut off the British troops. Unfortunately, hidden by the fog, many of Sir William Howe's troops had crossed Brandywine Creek further upstream. The battle raged for hours as General Wilhelm von Kynphausen's troops engaged the Americans from the front, while Howe's troops came around the flank. Washington was trapped between the two, and it appeared that his entire army would be decimated.

Washington ordered Nathaniel Green's troops to act as a rear guard, and to engage Howe's troops, while the rest of the army escaped to the Northeast. Green's troops fought valiantly, and although there were 1,300 casualties, the Continental Army survived to fight another day.

Congress was meeting that day. The Congressmen could hear the sound of cannon fire, and knew that they too, would soon have to retreat from the hall where they met. What was the business of the day? What was so important that they had to meet in the middle of such a conflict? A Congressional Committee, after consulting with Dr. Allison, an early congressional chaplain, recommended to Congress that they appropriate \$2 million (today's currency) to purchase 20,000 Bibles from Scotland and Holland to distribute across the Union. Under British rule, the Americans had to order all of their Bibles from Great Britain. In fact, it was illegal for them to print the Bible in America. So, when the Revolutionary War began, there was a shortage of Bibles. On that day, Congress approved the purchase, and the Committee on Commerce was instructed to obtain the Bibles because the Bible was "so universal and important".

In modern day America, the Bible is just as important, maybe more so, than it was on that day. As we are engaged in the spiritual battles concerning racism, the defense of traditional marriage, ending abortion, and LGBTQI+ agenda, it is vital that we take time to read and study God's Word. It is our only hope.

May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you.
