Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

Merry Christmas! I can't wait to celebrate this season with you. Our choir has been working diligently on music that will stir our souls. Our children have been working on a Christmas play that will not only be entertaining but will draw our attention to the true meaning of

Christmas. You have been generous with your giving to Operation Christmas Child, to the Lottie Moon Offering, and to the Donna Pittman Toy Store. And while you may never meet the people who benefit from your generosity, it is my hope that the joy of giving will fill your heart with joy.

Speaking of filling our hearts, I plan to use our Sunday morning time to talk about the "Heart of Christmas." What is Christmas really all about? And if it would be given to them, then we can rest assured it is offered to us as well. Now that is good news for a world that is in turmoil. The heart of Christmas is love. At just the right time, Jesus came into the world. He came to free us from the crushing weight of the law. We could never be good enough to earn salvation, so Jesus lived a perfect life on our behalf. Why? Because of love. God wanted us to be a part of His family. Out of love He adopted us through the work of Christ. We are now the sons and daughters of God. Jesus is our brother, and we can rest in the love of the Father.
