

### Dear Family God of Philadelphia,

During World War II, with a quarter of a million German troops fleeing through the Ardennes Forest, three Americans fleeing in a jeep should not have raised any alarm. But when they were stopped just a few miles west of Aywaille, Belgium, Privates Charles Lawrence,

Clarence van der Wert, and George Sensenback spoke very poor English and did not know the password of the day. It was discovered that they were part of a German operation known as Operation Greif, a Top-Secret commando raid hoping to infiltrate the Supreme Allied Headquarters to kill or capture General Dwight D. Eisenhower. Members of this operation were trained by watching American films to teach them how to salute like an American GI. They were taught to smoke like Americans, "never right down to the butt, and put them out." They were given daily lessons on American slang, and even taught profanity. Although it was a good plan, fortunately, it only had minor success.

As part of the plan, these "highly trained" commandos were parachuted behind enemy lines, to blend in with the Americans and cause as much chaos as possible. One of their missions was to change the road signs ahead of American troop advancements so that the soldiers would be sent in the wrong direction. With no GPS to guide them, if they had trusted the signs and not their maps and compasses, this could have been a devasting.

This story reminds me of what is happening in our culture in America today. Satan and his allies have infiltrated our government, our education system, and yes even our churches, and have changed the signposts that we have always known to be true. They have redefined marriage; confused a generation about gender; rewritten history; challenged what is right and wrong; and have forsaken universal truth. And millions have decided to follow the "cultural signs", rather than trusting what they know in their hearts to be true. Proverbs 23:10-12 in The Message Bible says this: "Don't stealthily move back the boundary lines or cheat orphans out of their property, for they have a powerful Advocate who will go to bat for them. Give yourselves to disciplined instruction; open your ears to tested knowledge." I would suggest to you that is exactly what we have done. We have "stealthily moved the boundaries" of truth, and "cheated our children" of the boundaries they so desperately need. I want to encourage us all to "open our ears" (and our mouths) to teach our children "tested knowledge." So that we can return to the Christian nation our Founding Fathers imagined. May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you.


