

Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

For those of us who are older, one of the hardest adaptations we have had to make is the acceptance of "participation awards" or "participation trophies." Go to any children's end of the year (or season) awards program or celebration, and you will find that every child gets an award of some kind. Whether the child has worked hard or been lazy, whether the child is talented or not, whether the child practiced or not, he or she knows that they are going to get a trophy or special recognition of some kind.

The idea behind this is commendable. We want every child to feel special, and to experience the joy of being honored. We want all children to enjoy being on an athletic team without making winning the only goal.

But there are also some lessons to be learned in winning and losing. It is important for children to learn at an early age that working hard for a goal matters. And while "showing up" matters, those who merely show up never know the sense of accomplishment that comes from knowing that your hard work played a part in making the team successful. They also miss the important lesson of accountability. Each player on the team must do his or her best, or the rest of the team suffers. What is true for children on the ballfield is also true for members of the church. Paul talks about this in I Corinthians 12. In verses 26 - 27, Paul writes this: "And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it. Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually."

There are a lot of church members who want a "trophy" or special recognition for "just showing up." And while showing up is important, these members cheat themselves out of the blessing that comes with knowing that God is using them to make a difference in the church, in the community, and even in the Kingdom of God.

On Sunday mornings, I really enjoy listening to our choir. Because of their hard work, we are all blessed and encouraged. Because of the dedication of our Sunday School teachers, adults and children are being discipled to become more like Christ. By Sunday evening, our AWANA leaders are exhausted. But because they are willing to serve, our children are "hiding God's Word in their hearts." And of course, none of these things would be possible without those who are willing to sacrificially give to our offering each week.

Don't miss the blessing that comes by giving your all for Christ. Showing up is important. But don't settle for a "participation trophy."

May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you. **RCA**
