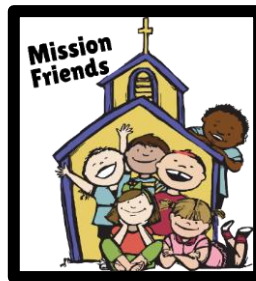

Dear Family of God of Philadelphia,

President Theodore Roosevelt once said, *“In the pioneer days of the West, we found it an unfailing rule that after a community had existed for a certain length of time, either a church was built or else the community began to go downhill.”*

In the 1830’s, French diplomat Alexis de Tocqueville toured America in search of the key to America’s greatness. When his tour was completed, he made this observation: *“I sought for the key to the greatness of America in her harbors...; in her fertile fields and boundless forests; in her rich mines and vast world commerce; in her public school system and institutions of learning. I sought for it in her democratic Congress and in her matchless Constitution. Not until I went into the churches of America and heard her pulpits aflame with righteousness did I understand the secret of her genius and power. America is great because America is good, and if America ever ceases to be good, America will cease to be great... The Americans combine the notions of Christianity and of liberty so intimately in their minds that it is impossible to make them conceive the one without the other.”*

Presidential candidate, Donald Trump has as his theme to *“Make America Great Again.”* America will never be great again until her churches are great again. And her churches never be great again until her members are willing to dedicate themselves completely to the Lord by serving the local church through generous giving, selfless serving and fervent praying.

If you consider Philadelphia Baptist to be your local church, ask yourself a question: *“Can Philadelphia Baptist Church be a great church if everyone has the same level of commitment as me?”* In other words, if everyone gave as I do, can we meet our budget obligations? If everyone prays for PBC like I pray for PBC, will God be able to do a great work here? If everyone serves like I serve, will the ministries of our church continue?

Our church is trying to make a difference in our community. During this month: we will celebrate what North Carolina Baptist Men have done around the world in part, through our giving; we will be serving college students at Wingate University, and encouraging them to become a part of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes; we will be serving a meal to *“the least of these”* at the Community Shelter; and we will be helping one of our young couples get off to good start with their household needs and another young couple with baby needs. But we can do none of these things without the faithfulness of God’s children.

If you are a part of our PBC family, please find your place to serve. Please give generously. And please pray for God to *“Make Our Churches Great Again.”*

May our Father bless you today. It is a joy to serve our Lord with you.
