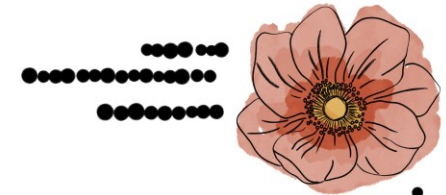
Annual Christmas in August Party 😊
