Hey Philadelphia Baptist Church Family,

It is starting off to be an exciting year for us. I am looking forward already to our mission trip in March and also all the summer ministry we will be doing together. One of the greatest parts of being a Southern Baptist is our international mission efforts. Many Southern Baptists do not know that we have an assigned international missionary to our church. I recently got in contact with ours. Her name is Melodie, she is in Panama, not Panama City in Florida but in the Central America country. This is what she sent me:

2025 marked **180 years** of Southern Baptists partnering through the International Mission Board to bring the gospel to the nations!

For nearly two centuries, the generosity and sacrifice of Southern Baptists have enabled Christ's name to be proclaimed through IMB missionaries, like me. Such steadfast, faithful support has now yielded Baptist mission organizations and local ministry partners around the world who are working together with IMB for the spread of the gospel.

Like Danilo Miranda, a colleague of mine who grew up in Brazil. Danilo says: "When I was 12 years old, an IMB missionary came to my church in Brazil and started teaching an adults Sunday school class. I went to his class with my mother and sat on the ground right next to him, hanging on to every word he said.

"He explained the Scriptures in my heart language of Portuguese. He taught us practical elements of discipleship, evangelism, and church planting. He was a faithful, steadfast presence in my life at the moment I most needed – when God was at work in my heart, calling me to serve Him.

"Your support of IMB missionaries provided the discipleship that led to my calling to take the gospel to the nations. I have spent my life serving God among Indigenous peoples and am now mobilizing Brazilian Baptists to take the gospel not only to Brazilians but to the world."

Local ownership of the Great Commission is crucial to fulfilling the Revelation 7:9 vision. As IMB missionaries, we are working diligently to train global partners to reach the world, but our partnerships with Southern Baptist churches like yours have a direct impact on gospel access, gospel belief, and gospel multiplication among the nations.
